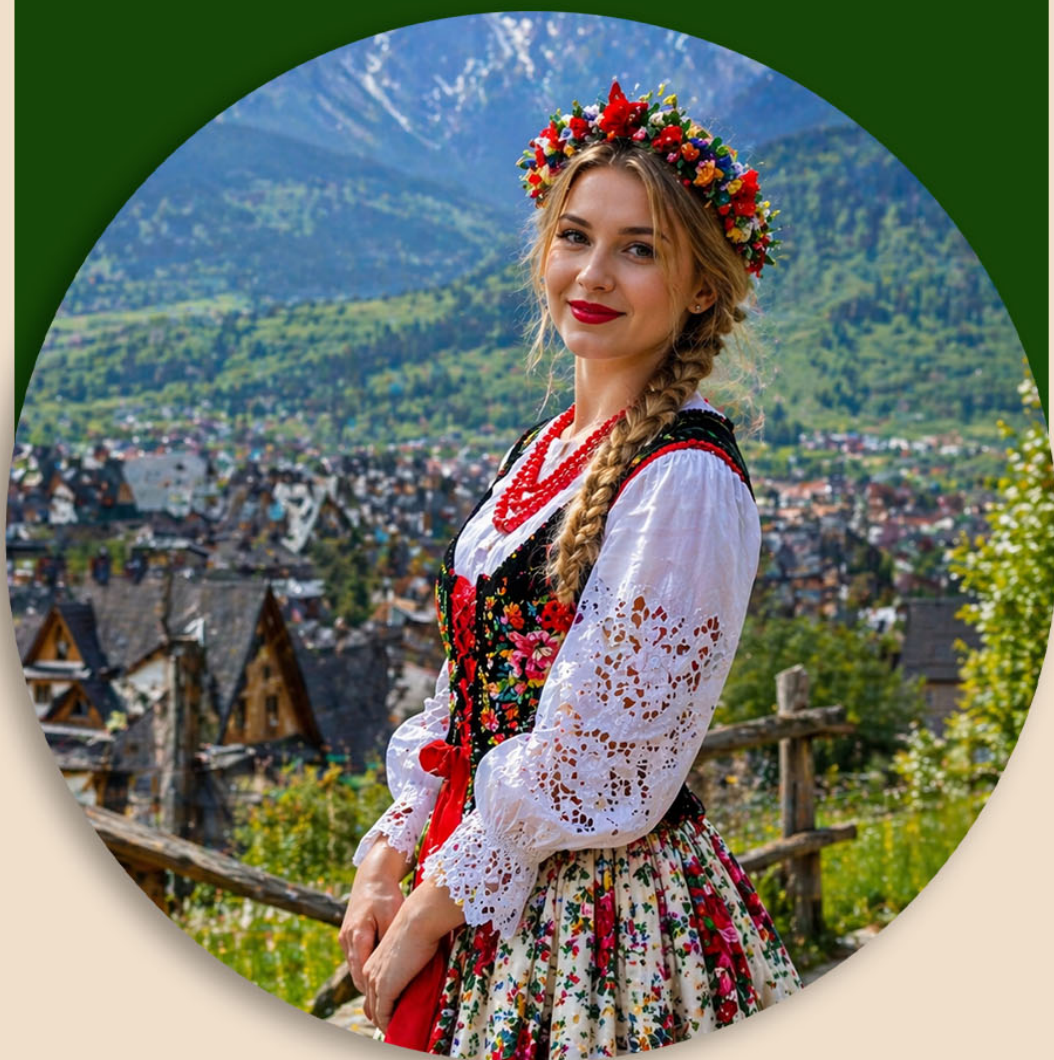

Day by Day Itinerary

Day 1 – Saturday, August 8, 2026

Upon arrival in Prague and completing the passport formalities, we are greeted by a local guide and head to the hotel to rest for a while. In the evening, we go for a walk and walk on the Charles Bridge take rest in a 4* hotel

Day 2 – Sunday, August 9, 2026

Breakfast at the hotel, full day tour of Prague including Prague Castle, city center, Astronomical Clock and Dancing House, free time for shopping and night walking tour, take rest in 4* hotel

Day 3 – Monday, August 10, 2026

Breakfast at the hotel, check-in and departure to Vienna, on the way to visit the city of Cesky Krumlov and continue to Vienna. Check-in, free time for a night walking tour, take rest in a 4* hotel

Day 4 – Tuesday, August 11, 2026

Breakfast at the hotel, full day tour of Schönbrunn Palace, dinner on the Danube River cruise, free time for shopping and evening walking tour, take rest in a 4* hotel

Day 5 – Wednesday, August 12, 2026

Breakfast at the hotel, full-day tour of Vienna including visiting Belvedere Palace, Opera House, Hofburg Square, City Hall, city center, free time for shopping or walking, return to the 4* hotel and take rest

Day 6 – Thursday, August 13, 2026

Breakfast at the hotel, check-in and departure from Vienna departure to Budapest, on the way visit Bratislava, free time and walk in the city center, continue to Budapest, arrival in Budapest, check-in at the hotel and free time. Take rest in a 4* hotel

Day 7 – Friday, August 15, 2026

Breakfast at the hotel, full-day city tour of Budapest including visits to Buda Castle, Parliament Building, Suspension Bridge, St. Stephen's Cathedral, walking along the Danube River, free time for walking or shopping, Take rest in a 4* hotel

Day 8 – Saturday, August 15, 2026

Breakfast at the hotel, check-out, departure to Krakow, transfer to the hotel and check-out, evening walk in the city center and visit the Cathedral of St. Mary (exterior view) and sightseeing in local markets. Return to the hotel. Take rest in a 4* hotel

Day 9 – Sunday, August 16, 2026

Breakfast at the hotel, full-day tour of Auschwitz–Birkenau camp, Schindler's Museum and Factory, Krakow's Jewish Quarter, free time in the city center for shopping or walking, Take rest in 4* hotel

Day 10 – Monday, August 17, 2026

You have the whole day at your disposal to relax, or explore the city of Krakow at your own pace and prepare to continue your journey into the mountainous region the next day. Take rest in a 4* hotel

Day 11 – Tuesday, August 18, 2026

Breakfast at the hotel, check out of the hotel and head to the Zakopane mountain area, visit the huts of villagers and shepherds, taste smoked cheeses and various local drinks, continue the journey by cable car and finally use the mineral springs while enjoying the scenery. Take rest in a 4* hotel

Day 12 – Wednesday, August 19, 2026

Breakfast at the hotel, free time until noon, check out of the hotel and transfer to Krakow airport according to the flight schedule for your return trip. End of a memorable Central European trip
